### Program Details - Team Structure

#### Competition Team(s)

Upon completion of the tryout process, the coaching staff will select 12 players to become members of the competition team(s). Participation on the competition team requires a very high level of dedication and commitment. Players selected for the competition team will be required to attend 1–3 team practices per week (determined by the coaching staff) as well as an individual or small group practice featuring “one on one” coaching. Team members will also attend regular team meetings to discuss a variety of topics including but not limited to goal setting, team building, upcoming tournaments, and academic progress. The Competition team(s) will compete in 6–14 tournaments per season and strive to qualify for the Intercollegiate Team Championships.

#### Developmental Team

Upon completion of the tryout process, the coaching staff will also select players to be members of the developmental team. The developmental team players will be required to attend team practice(s) and/or individual lesson(s). The developmental team(s) may compete in 1–6 tournaments or scrimmages per season.
